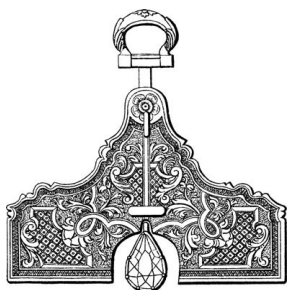

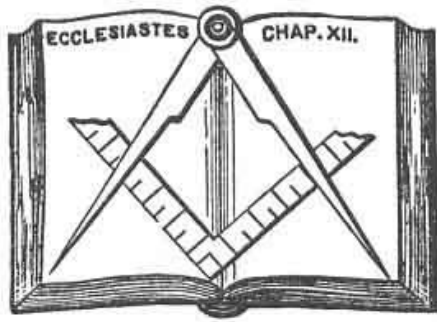

The Hall Association members need to be thanked for the work they did and coming to all those Monday night meetings, especially when your favorite football team was playing on Monday Night Football.

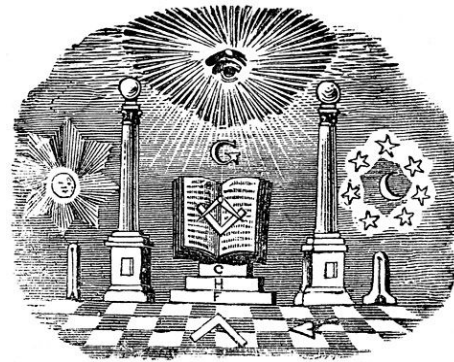
We hope that 2017 will bring improvements to the lodge and there be no major emergencies.

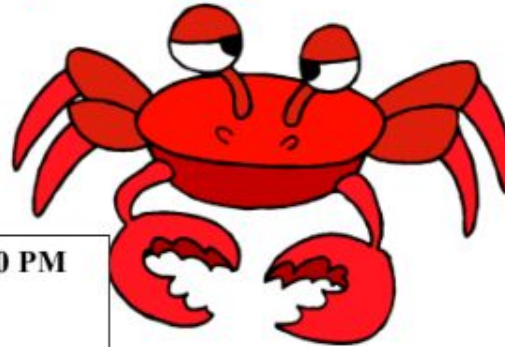

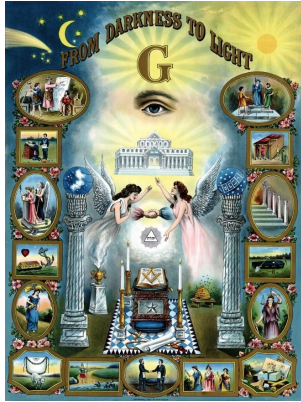
