REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE CONCERNING THE COST IMPACT OF LEGISLATION FOR THE 168th ANNUAL COMMUNICATION

In accordance with *California Masonic Code* §406.035, the Grand Lodge Committee on Finance has reviewed the resolutions to be considered at the 168th Annual Communication and has prepared the following estimate of the cost impact of each to Grand Lodge, if adopted.

CARRY-OVER LEGISLATION

The committee has reviewed Carry-Over Legislation from 2016 and finds that none of this legislation will have a financial impact on the Grand Lodge budget.

NEW RESOLUTIONS

The committee has reviewed the new Resolutions 17-01 through 17-08 and finds that none of this legislation will have a financial impact on the Grand Lodge budget.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Carry-over and new Resolutions may propose changes to the Ritual or the Monitor. It has been a practice of the Grand Lodge to make the printed changes and produce new ciphers and monitors only after the current inventory has been depleted. Therefore, there is no additional expense caused by the adoption of these Resolutions.
